St John's World Book Day 2018



This year our World Book Day will focus on the well-known Where's Wally character. The teachers have planned lots of activities which will include a 'Where's Wally hunt,' shared writing activities, photographic work and lots of creative art work. The children will be the authors and illustrators on the day. Prizes will be awarded. All this will culminate in our very own St. John's Where's Wally book which will be kept in the school library for children to read at their leisure.

Where's Wally was chosen due to its multiple strategy teaching opportunities. It seeks to help children to analyse, interpret and evaluate. The book also helps develop skimming and scanning skills.

Analysis of the profile of marks in the May 2017 Year 2 SAT Reading test showed that 25% of the total marks were 'making inferences from the text.' In the Year 6 SAT Reading test, 44% of the marks were 'make inferences from the text and explain and justify inferences with evidence from the text'. The Where's Wally books most importantly help develop children's inference and deduction skills.

We understand that some children have already made their costume and if this is the case, they may wear that costume on the day. However, we do hope that as many children as possible will enter into the spirit of our theme.
