Morning routines

- Arrive in the playground by 8.45am
- Children will then go up the stairs and into the classroom
- Find peg and put away coat
- Put book bag in the set box
- The children will then carry out an early work activity set by the teacher

Afternoon dismissal

- Children will be dismissed at 3.15pm.
- They will line up in the bottom hall by the doors they will be dismissed from (the first glass doors nearest the black gate)
- Once the class teacher has seen a parent or carer they will call the child's name so that they can leave.
- Any child that is not picked up by 3.30pm will be taken to the school office.
- If you would like to speak to your child's teacher then please wait till all children have been dismissed.

- Children's own work

How you can support over the summer

- Read with your child as often as you can (both them reading to you and you reading to them)
- Encourage them to practise writing (maybe keep a diary, write shopping lists, letters to their new teacher)
- Practise phonics (use the sound books)
- Encourage independence (getting them to dress themselves, packing their own school bag, doing some work on their own e.g. reading a book, writing a sentence)
